Town & Country Fine Foods has achieved Planet Mark Certified - Business by reporting its measured carbon emissions, reducing Scope 1 and 2 emissions (market-based) by 6.5% compared to the previous reporting period, and by committing to expand its measurement boundary to measure up to a full carbon footprint. Compared to the previous reporting period 2024, Town & Country Fine Foods has also reduced its market-based, measured carbon emissions by 5.7% and its market-based measured carbon emissions per turnover by 5.7%.
